CAMEL Valley in Cornwall has been producing world-class wines for more than 15 years.

The 10-acre family-run vineyard was originally planted in 1989 and produces about 35,000 bottles of red, white, rose and sparkling wine each year.

Even renowned celebrity chef Rick Stein has served the Cornwall Sparkling Brut at his famous fish restaurant in Padstow.

Camel Valley is an excellent ambassador of "taste" for the South West and it has shown that the region can produce internationally recognised wines.

The vineyards have also won numerous awards including the 2001 English Wine Producers trophy and the South West Vineyards Best Sparkling Wine trophy for 2004 Camel Valley Cornwall Brut.

Camel Valley is not just a working vineyard, as visitors are also invited for informative and entertaining tours of the winery and vineyard.

The Camel Valley tours include wine tasting, where visitors learn how the grapes are transformed into the famous wines, or tutored

wine-tasting days where they are treated to some of the secrets of producing the best grapes in the English climate. Perhaps the wines taste so good because of the vineyard's special terrain, or perhaps it is due to the region's climate, but whatever it is, this could not have been achieved without the dedication and passion of the Camel Valley team.
